### The Poul la Cour Museum celebrates its 20th anniversary.

It was 20 years ago that the Poul la Cour Museum opened its doors to the public and it should be celebrated. We should have held it in the spring, but like so many other events we had to postpone it - but now we think it succeeds.

The anniversary is held over 2 days:

Friday, October 8, 2021 at 13.30 the official part will be held, where we hope that many of those we have had contact with over the years will come. Take the opportunity to come and say hello and see what we have achieved in the last 20 years. There will be speeches and posts from different people and there will be a little food served. Also join a small tour of our locations.

Saturday, October 9, 2021 at 9.00 we hold an open house for Askov town and surroundings, as well as everyone else who did not come by on Friday. Between 9 and 10 coffee and rolls will be served. Bring the children with you and we will build some small wind turbines with them while you look around. Saturday's event ends at 12.00

Registration is not required for either Friday or Saturday.

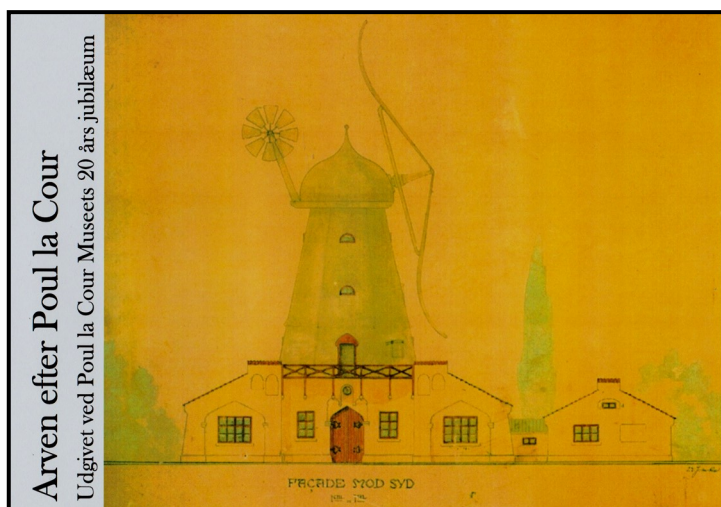
In connection with the anniversary, a 64-page book entitled "The Legacy of Poul la Cour" will be published. The book tells the whole story of Poul la Cour's great-grandfather, Pierre la Cour, who was born in 1716 in Germany, how he came to Denmark, about how his son buys an estate in Djursland, and of course about his great-grandson Poul la Cour, who becomes one of Denmark's great inventors. It tells how Poul la Cour came to Askov in 1878, and what happens to his experimental centre after his death in 1908, all the way up to the year 2000, when we buy the place. The story ends with a presentation of what is going on in the old buildings today.

The book is handed out free of charge to our guests who come to the anniversary. If you cannot come to the anniversary, the book can be sent against payment of 15 EUR for shipment abroad. **Please note:** The hard copy is only available in Danish. An English version will be available on our homepage later. The amount can be paid either to our bank account - see bottom of page. When paying, remember to give your name and address and please write BOOK.

If you want to round up the amount a bit, the extra amount will go to the purchase of hydrogen equipment, which we lack for our teaching. If you intend to bring a small gift, you can instead deposit a contribution into our bank account, but it is not expected that you bring anything. We look forward to seeing you in Askov.
